The successful candidate must be accredited with the CRM Section of the Association of Southern African Professional Archaeologists and registration with the Association of Professional Heritage Practitioners (APHP) will be a distinct advantage. The candidate must be experienced in archaeological fieldwork (site surveys, sampling strategies and heritage site management), be prepared to travel extensively and they must be prepared to work as part of a likeminded team of specialists. Proven experience and skills in Archaeological and Heritage Impact Assessment specialist report writing is required and a record of scientific publications will be advantageous.
