Coastal and Environmental Services (CES) seeks an experienced consultant to run their environmental monitoring unit. An MSc with at least 2 years' experience, or an Honours degree with five years' experience is required. A formal qualification in chemistry will be a distinct advantage, and in the absence of this significant experience relating to water quality will be required. The primary function is to manage the various water monitoring contracts, the two technicians who undertake sampling, to liaise with laboratories, and to prepare monthly and quarterly reports. These reports need to interpret longer term trends and compare results against various parameters. Data interpretation skills and the management of large databases is required, as is an ability to synthesise, interpret and provide recommendations on water quality results. Primary skills therefore include familiarity with compliance testing, water use in mining and other industries, data handling, an understanding of water chemistry and report writing skills.
